SUBJECT: Release of Manufacturer Discount Program Quarterly Invoice File
Layouts and 2025 Updates to Coverage Gap Discount Program Quarterly
Invoice and Dispute File Layouts

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is announcing the release of file layouts for the Manufacturer Discount Program’s (Discount Program) sponsor and manufacturer invoice detail (data), summary, and tracking reports. The file layouts, while similar to the equivalent Coverage Gap Discount Program (CGDP) report layouts, reflect the inclusion of the additional data elements that were announced in the November 17, 2023, memorandum titled “Medicare Part D Manufacturer Discount Program Final Guidance.” The layouts can be found on the [Part D Information for Pharmaceutical Manufacturers](#) website and will be effective for the 2025Q1 Discount Program quarterly invoice cycle.

CMS is also releasing file layout changes for the CGDP quarterly invoice and dispute reports. In the April 18, 2023 memorandum, “New 2025 Prescription Drug Event (PDE) File Layouts (FINAL),” CMS released updated Prescription Drug Event (PDE) file layouts that are effective beginning January 1, 2025 for all Dates of Service. To reflect the relevant changes to the PDE file layouts for the remaining CGDP invoice and dispute processes, it is necessary to make updates to the invoice and dispute file layouts. The updated CGDP file layouts are available on the TPA website at <https://www.tpadministrator.com/> under the Invoices tab and the Disputes tab, and each Report Name below is hyperlinked to the applicable webpage.

The new file layouts for the following [CGDP data and tracking report files](#) will take effect beginning with the 2024Q4 CGDP invoice cycle, to be distributed in January 2025.

CGDP Report Name	Changes for 2025
<u>Contract Data Report (10CDT)</u>	PRODUCT SERVICE ID will increase from X(19) to X(40)
<u>Coverage Gap Tracking Report (10CGT)</u>	PRODUCT SERVICE ID will increase from X(19) to X(40) & REPORTED GAP DISCOUNT AMOUNT will increase from S9(6)V99 to S9(9)V99
<u>Manufacturer Data Report (10MDT)</u>	PRODUCT SERVICE ID will increase from X(19) to X(40)

The new file layouts for the following CGDP dispute process files will take effect beginning with the 2024Q4 CGDP dispute cycle. Except for the Manufacturer Dispute Resolution (10DRS) file and Contract Dispute (10CDR) file, the 2024Q3 CGDP dispute cycle will continue to use the existing file layouts. The 2024Q3 Manufacturer Dispute Resolution (10DRS) file and Contract Dispute (10CDR) file will use the new file layout.

<u>Manufacturer Dispute Submission File (10DSP)</u>	PRODUCT SERVICE ID will increase from X(19) to X(40)
<u>Manufacturer Dispute Return File (10DRT)</u>	PRODUCT SERVICE ID will increase from X(19) to X(40)
<u>Manufacturers Dispute Resolution File (10DRS)</u>	PRODUCT SERVICE ID will increase from X(19) to X(40). The total record length of this file will be expanded from 1024 to 1060 bytes.
<u>Manufacturer Reimbursement Detail Report (12UMD)</u>	PRODUCT SERVICE ID will increase from X(19) to X(40)
<u>Upheld Dispute Tracking File (12UMT)</u>	DISPUTED PRODUCT SERVICE ID and PRODUCT SERVICE ID will both increase from X(19) to X(40)
<u>Contract Reimbursement Detail Report (12UCD)</u>	PRODUCT SERVICE ID will increase from X(19) to X(40)
<u>Contract Dispute File (10CDR)</u>	PRODUCT SERVICE ID will increase from X(19) to X(40). The total record length of this file will be expanded from 250 to 275 bytes.
